ESSENTIAL AND OTHER IMPORTANT JOB DUTIES

Essential Duties

This position will be assigned various duties in the field to which the positions is assigned. Duties may include but are not limited to: performs analysis of City operations and cost alternatives; prepares reports outlining recommendations; does research on the potential impacts of pending state and federal legislation affecting the City; attends City Commission meetings and workshops; assists higher-level personnel in performing special studies, projects and conducting research; prepares reports, forms and correspondence; assists with general administrative duties that are determined by the area to which the position is assigned; and performs related work as required.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills

Knowledge of the theories, concepts, and principles of a City management track, as obtained through successful completion of the required courses in public administration. Knowledge of the principles of office management and clerical, statistical and fiscal processing. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships as necessitated by the work. Ability to express oneself clearly and concisely, orally and in writing. Skill in the use of personal computers and associated programs and applications necessary for successful job performance.

Minimum Training and Experience

Must possess a bachelor's degree and be currently enrolled in course work for a master's degree in the field in which the position is assigned; or must have obtained a master's degree or higher in the field to which the position is assigned no more than two semesters prior to end of internship.

At the time of application, must be authorized to work in the United States and must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above.
